Building is listed as the "Brenham Pulp Factory" in 1891 and by 1896 is listed as a steam laundry.

Building opens as a flour, grain and cotton warehouse. A laundry is located on the north portion of the building.

In 2023 the building was purchased and tranformed into the Laundry Event Hall

## **2016** 4 STAR CONCERT HALL

Before the building was scheduled for demolition, John Elford purchased 209 S. Market and transforms it into the 4 Star Concert Hall. The hall hosted many concerts until John's death in 2021.
